Qualifications/Training

- Ability to demonstrate personal and professional integrity by abiding by the code of ethics that suppresses the disclosure of any confidential information about group members or any discussions outside the group session.
- Possess past and present relatability, learnings, and life application.
- Able to attend (2) mandatory two-hour Facilitator training sessions in July, 2019.

Responsibilities

Demonstrate satisfactory communication, listening and social skills.

- Be able to enable participative discussions and learning among group members, allowing them to express and present different opinions while maintaining a respectful environment.
- Facilitate the exploration of different Christ-breathed perspectives among group members (including self-care) related to carrying out this ministry of compassion, both spiritually and in actual service.
